
ALEKS Review, Reports & Progress

How to Review completed topics & Access your Progress Reports (including topic details, and Time & Topic Report)


This document explains how you can view your ALEKS course progress and details of Time and topics completed. You can **Review** completed topics again, if you wish to do so [**See Step 2 below**].

- 1. Student logs in using his/her ALEKS username/password
- 2. Student selects Reports upper right of screen. You can also go to Options and select "view your latest ALEKS report" from Report line.



Choose **Review** from above menu, if you want to redo/review topics already completed.

3. After selecting the Reports link the screen would look similar to this:



You can pick any of the 3 tabs here to view **Your Time and Topic Report** (How much time spent on Aleks), **Common Core Standard** or **Pie Report**.

4. Scroll Down on **Pie Report** tab to see additional information such as.


