

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION and APPLICATION FORM

DEADLINE: FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2008
(For the academic year 2008-09)

The scholarships that are available through the DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES are the Cummins Scholarship and the Harshbarger Scholarship. The eligibility requirements for the scholarships are listed below.

Cummins Scholarship

In order to be eligible for this award, the applicant must be a mathematics major or applied mathematics major with junior standing (i.e., at least 60 semester hours earned) or a mathematics education major with junior standing at Kent State University. The amount of this award is variable.

Harshbarger Scholarship

In order to be eligible for this award, the applicant must be a mathematics or applied mathematics major at Kent State University. The applicant must have also completed Math 12003 (Calculus II), Math 21001 (Linear Algebra), and either Math 22005 (Calculus III) or an upper-division mathematics course. The amount of this award is variable.

If you want to be considered for any of the scholarships above for which you are eligible, complete both sides of the attached form and bring or mail it, together with an official copy of your transcript, to Department of Mathematical Sciences, Kent State University, Kent, Ohio 44242, Attention: Virginia Wright. Please note that the Cummins and Harshbarger Scholarships require three letters of recommendation. **The deadline for receipt of all application materials, including official transcripts and letters of recommendation, is Friday, February 15, 2008.**

You may apply for any of the scholarships above for which you are eligible.
